

# Build it:

# TANKS

Recycle your old egg box and design a tank fit for combat! Make sure you decorate your tank in some camouflage patterns and colours.

## You will need:

**A cardboard egg box** (6 egg size works well)

**A selection of other recyclable materials** (small cereal box; empty (and clean!) yoghurt pot; plastic bottle lids, toilet roll tubes, lolly sticks; corrugated paper or cardboard etc).

**Glue stick or sellotape**

**Scissors**

## What to do:

Decide what features you would like your tank to have. Ask yourself:

- What size and shape will it be?
- What protective features will it need?
- How many soldiers will it carry?

Use your recyclable materials to construct the tank. Use your egg box as the basic shape to start from.

Use your other materials to sculpt the features of the tank, such as the tracks and the turret. What other features do you think a tank should have?

Decorate your tank with a design of your choice. Will you go for a traditional camouflage effect or something completely unique?!

How does your design compare to today's tanks? Did you take any inspiration from any historic tank designs? How do you think tanks could be better improved for the future?
